

BY-LAWS of

The Gold Coast Amateur Beekeeper's Society inc.

As amended 3 August 2020

Explanatory note

This document outlines the by-laws of The Gold Coast Amateur Beekeeper's Society inc. This is authorised by clause 42 of the GCABS constitution.

By-laws cover those matters or rules which, like the constitution, bind members who have agreed to abide by the constitution and by-laws through the application and renewal process.

By-laws may only be made or amended by the Management Committee. By-laws means by-laws made by the Management Committee (as amended) under clause 42(1), until they are repealed by the Management Committee under clause 42(1) or set aside by special resolution at a General Meeting under clause 42(2).

BY-LAW 1. FAMILY MEMBER

At their discretion and within reason, the Management Committee may admit an individual who desires identification with The Gold Coast Amateur Beekeeper's Society inc. and wishes to support its objectives; if they are a family member of an Ordinary Member. Family members are non-voting, but shall otherwise have all of the rights and privileges of membership.

Bylaw 1 repealed 03/08/2020 no new family members allocated, existing family members expire 30/06/2021.

BY-LAW 2. CODE OF PRACTICE

The Gold Coast Amateur Beekeeper's Society inc. and members adopt, endorse and abide by the current Australian Honey Bee Industry's Biosecurity Code of Practice.
